Our staff consists of **115** full-time, part-time and seasonal employees who are trained to guide, coach, and motivate kids to be successful.



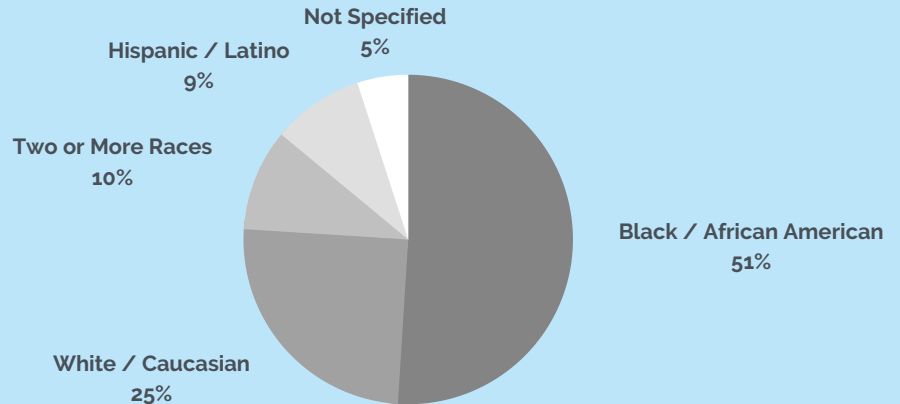

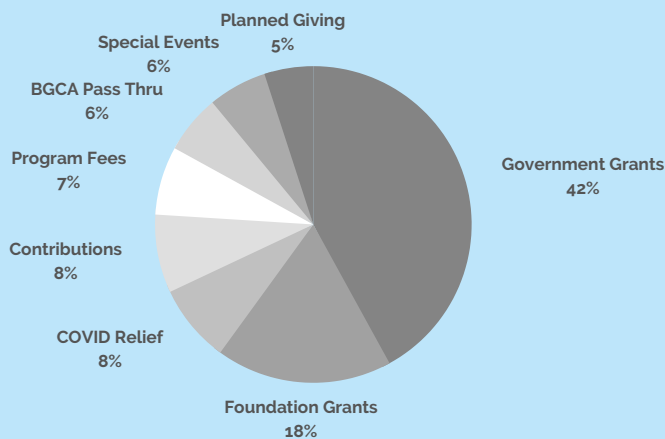

FINANCIAL *Overview*

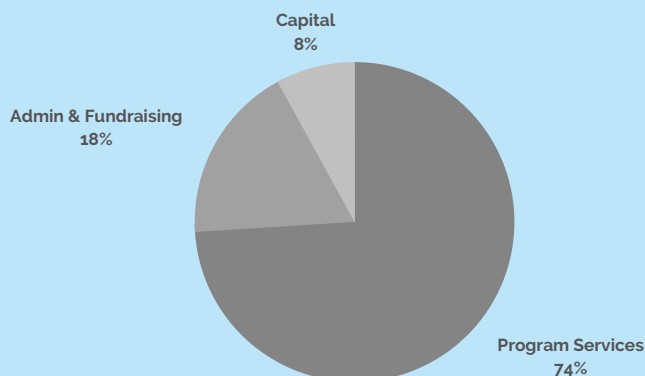
