



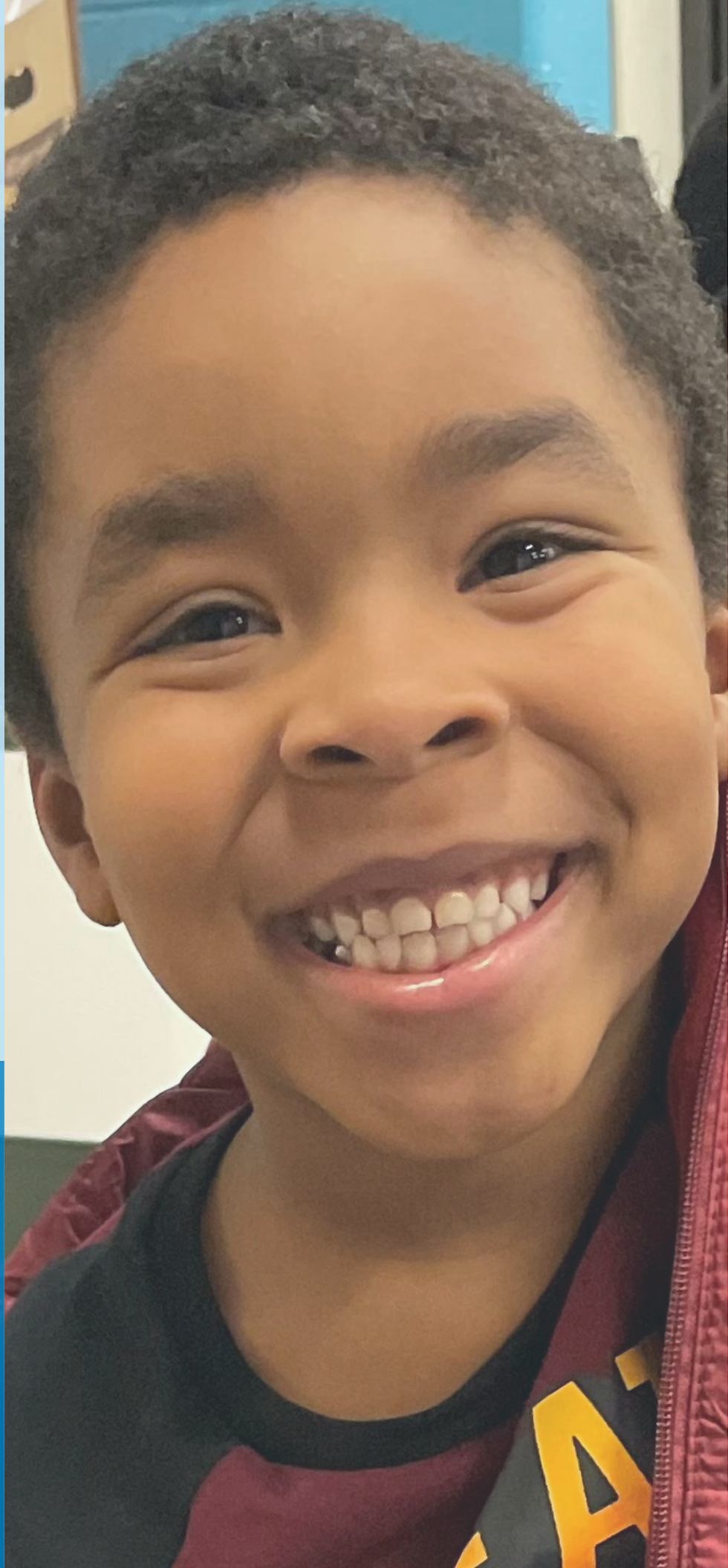

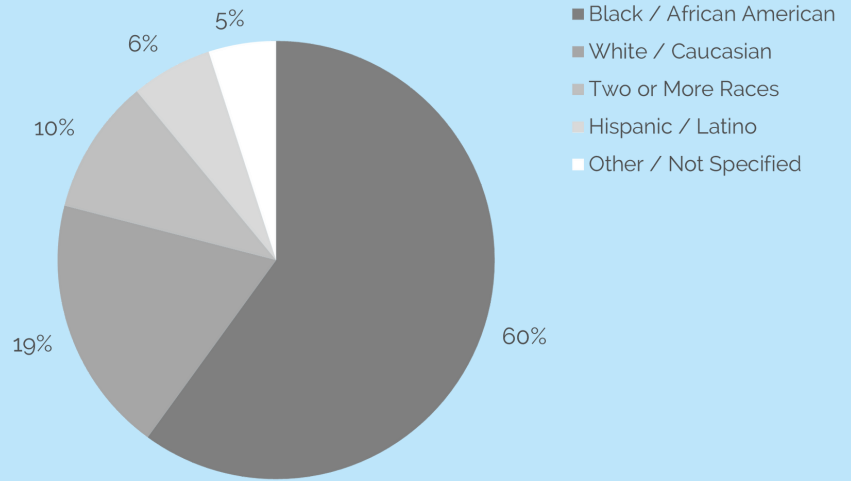

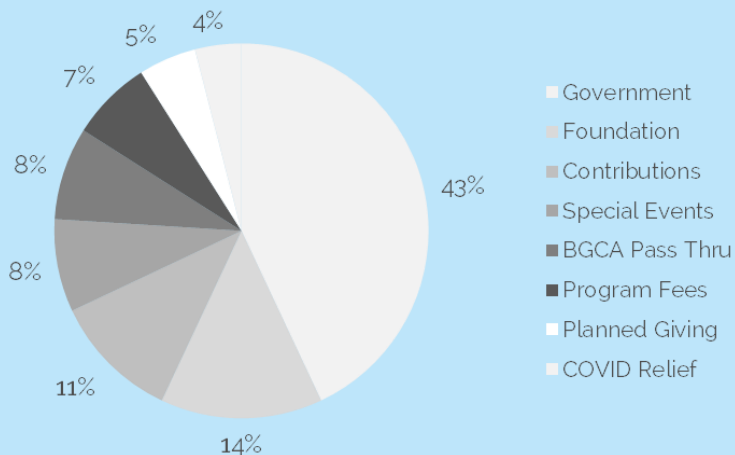

# FINANCIAL *Overview*

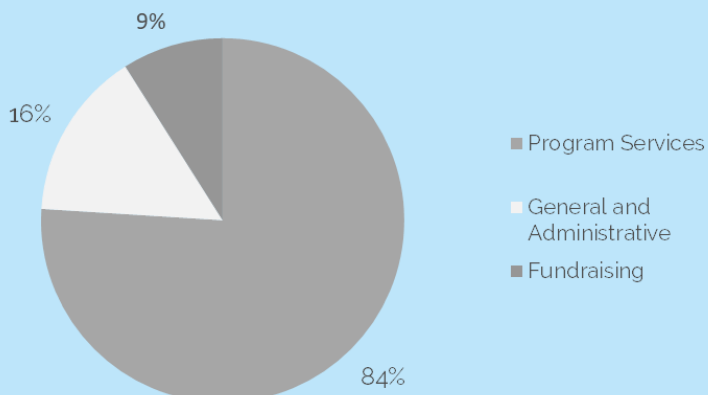
