
#### **Cow Craft**


Supplies Provided in this Packet: Black paper, paper plate, cow mouth & eyes

### **Activity: Space Shuttle Route to the Planet**

#### Supplies provided in this packet:

 Popsicle sticks, Paper clip, Magnet, Rocket, Two circles: one for Earth, one for your planet of choice

#### Things needed from home:

• Glue, Tape, Crayons or markers, Pencil, Scissors

The goal of this STEM activity is to help you learn about the solar system.

#### **Directions:**

Step 1: Watch the video on the solar system



Step 2: Choose a planet you want to visit. Draw and color the planet. Color your rocket.

**Step 3:** Using the cardboard, make a path out of the popsicle sticks from Earth to your planet. Plan your path before you glue the sticks to the cardboard, making sure the paperclip will navigate (go through the path) between the sticks. Glue the sticks to cardboard.

**Step 4:** Tape the paperclip to the underside of your rocket. Place your rocket on planet Earth. Place the magnet under the cardboard, lining it up with the rocket. Use the magnet to move the rocket along your path to your planet.

**Activity: Laundry Basket Golf** 

Supplies provided in this packet: N/A

<u>Things needed at home:</u> 1 sock ball (or beanbag) per player, 1 laundry basket or medium size box, a scoresheet (piece of paper), and a pencil

<u>Directions:</u> This is a 9 hole game... The object is to toss the sock ball/bean bag into the laundry basket/box in as few tosses as possible.

Move the laundry basket far enough away from where you'll start tossing the sock ball so that it's a challenge for those who are playing to make it in 1 toss. Take turns tossing your ball until you get it in the basket. (It's ok to use obstacles in the yard... tree, swing ect.in order to make it more difficult).

As always, the youngest player goes first followed by the next oldest and etc. After the first toss, the player furthest away will toss second and will do so until all players have tossed their ball into the laundry basket.

After all players have made their tosses, the basket may be relocated or the starting point may be changed. The player who got their ball in the basket first will start the second hole. At the end of the 9th hole, add up the score and the player with the lowest total tosses is the winner.




### Activity: Name 3 things board game
