
Supplies Provided in this Packet: Teeth brushing supplies, dental word search

#### Activity 2: Zebra Habitat Diorama

Supplies provided in this packet: Jar printout, Zebra coloring sheets

**<u>Things needed from home:</u>** Box (if you don't want to use the Jar printout), Paper, Crayons, Any materials of your choosing for the Diorama, Tape and/or glue.

#### The goal of this STEM activity is to teach children about animals and their habitats.

#### **Directions:**

Step 1: Review the videos from the San Diego Zoo and watch the following video <u>https://www.natgeokids.com/au/discover/animals/general-animals/zebra-facts/</u> for more information to create your habitat.

Step 2: Create your own zebra habitat diorama using a box or the enclosed Jar printout. If you use the jar printout, cover your finished diorama with cellophane (Saran Wrap<sup>®</sup>) to make it look like glass.

Step 3: Cut out the zebras and color. If you use the box, don't cut the tabs off. Fold the tab and tape the tab to your box to make your animal stand up.

Step 4: Take a photo.

Step 5: Describe your habitat using the following questions. Write about what you learned about Zebras.

> Where do they live? What do they eat? Other interesting facts
