

THE CLUB TEEN CENTER

The CLUB is a space within the Boys & Girls Club created especially for teens. *The CLUB* offers resources and programs to create meaningful experiences today as teens prepare a plan for the future.

- *The CLUB* is for high school teens currently in 9th-12 grade. Rising 9th graders (current 8th graders) will be part of the Summer 2023 High School Program
- Members of the High School Program have access to the *The CLUB* Teen Center that includes a pool table and game area, multiple gaming stations, a large screen for television and videos, general gathering area, computer stations and designated study rooms
- Only currently registered program members are allowed inside the *The CLUB* Teen Center

CHECK-IN / CHECK-OUT

- Members of the High School Program will enter through *The CLUB* entrance (located to the left of the covered drive-thru area). Members will receive a scan card and will be required to scan in when they arrive. Only High School Program members may use the side door. All other members will enter through the right side doors under the covered drive-thru area.
- Members must scan out each time they leave and scan in each time they return to *The CLUB*.

HIGH SCHOOL PROGRAM POLICIES AND EXPECTATIONS

You will indicate on your registration form whether you agree or do not agree with the High School Program Policies and Expectations. If you select that you agree, the below policies will apply. If you select that you do not agree, your child will not be allowed to leave unless he/she is formally checked out by a parent / guardian; however, the rest of the rules still apply. It is important that you notify your child of your expectations. Club staff will do everything it can to prevent a child from leaving but it is still the child's responsibility to follow your wishes and *The CLUB* rules. If a child attempts or leaves *The CLUB* without your permission, Club staff will notify the parent immediately.

High School Program members **ARE** permitted to:

- Leave *The CLUB* at their discretion, including with a person not on their pickup list or by walking or driving
- Check out with a scan card, just like parents have for the purpose of checking out their children
- Return to the building, after having left, provided it is during regular operating hours
- Order food from delivery services or bring in their own food from outside *The CLUB*
- Go outside the building to retrieve items from their cars, make short phone calls, or receive food from delivery drivers

High School Program members **ARE NOT** permitted to:

- Leave the building without notifying the Teen Center staff and having been formally checked-out
- Loiter in the parking lot
- Bring food in the building and distribute to anyone who is not visiting in the capacity as a High School Program member including siblings and staff
- Have food received at *The CLUB* by any person other than him- or herself, including staff
