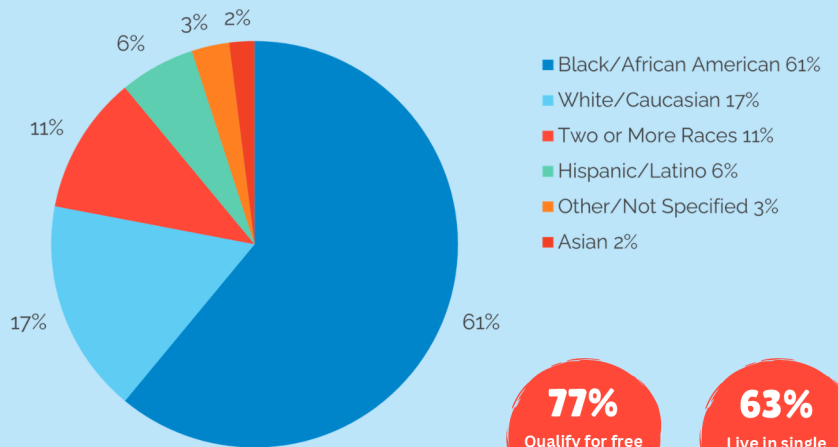

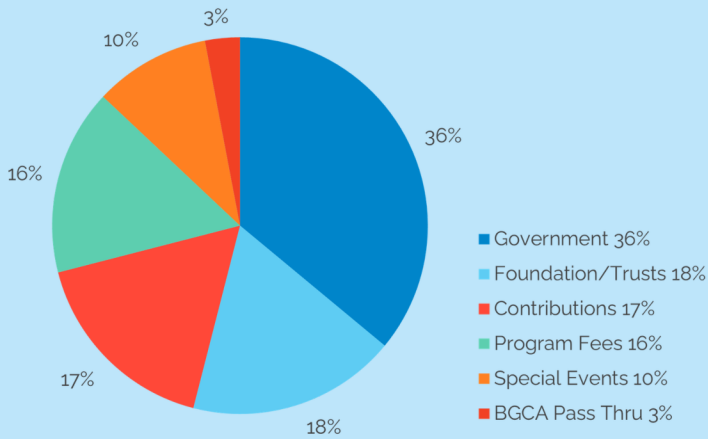

FINANCIAL Overview

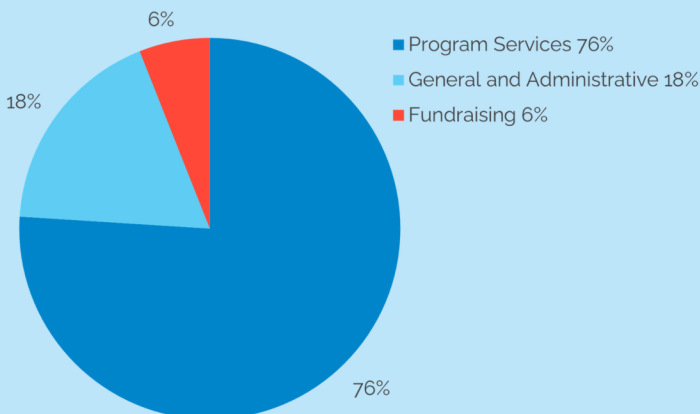
