- High School: There is currently no fee for the high school Summer Program





## ABOUT THE PROGRAM

Our Teen program is for students in grades 6-12 and operates in the same way our Afterschool and Summer Programs operate.

During the school year, transportation is provided from school to the Club from the following middle and high schools:

Concord Middle, CC Griffin, JN Fries, Northwest Cabarrus Middle, Roberta Road Middle, Winkler Middle, Central Cabarrus, Concord High, Northwest Cabarrus, West Cabarrus High

Students from other schools may attend, but transportation is not provided.

Transportation is not provided in the summer.

High School Teen Program members have the option of joining the Keystone Club, which will involve participation in community service projects, special events, and volunteering inside and outside the Club.

Afternoon snack/dinner is provided at no additional cost.

## TEEN PROGRAM SCHEDULE

### Afterschool Program

- Middle School: Monday-Friday, 4:30pm-7:00pm
- High School: Monday-Friday, 2:30pm-7:00pm
- The Club is open from 7:30 AM to 7:00 PM on School Closing Days at no extra cost.

### Summer Program

- Program operates Monday through Friday from 7:30am-6:30pm
- Program is for children in grades 6-12 (during the prior school year)

## CODE OF CONDUCT

## TEEN-ONLY SPACES

Teens have access to their own dedicated spaces designed for hanging out, connecting, and just being themselves. Whether they're studying, spending time with friends, or diving into fun activities, our Teen Rooms offer a welcoming place to relax, explore new interests, and feel right at home.

## THE KEYSTONE CLUB

- The Keystone Club is a Boys & Girls Clubs of America teen program for students in grades 9-12. Its focus is to provide teens an opportunity to gain valuable leadership and service experience.
- To enroll in the Keystone Club, the student must first be enrolled as a Teen Afterschool Program Member.
- Keystone Club members must attend weekly meetings which are held on a designated weekday evening. They will also be required to complete a set amount of volunteer hours through community service projects, participating in special events, and volunteering inside and outside the Club.
- High School Afterschool Program members who wish to also participate in the Keystone Club may do so with no additional fee.
- High school students can enroll in the High School Afterschool Program without being required to participate in the Keystone Club.

## SNACKS/DINNER

Afternoon snacks/dinner are provided each day through the Second Harvest Food Bank Kids' Café Program and NCDHHS Child and Adult Food Program. Children are also welcome to bring their own snacks from home. The Club does not provide substitute foods to offset allergies.
