OUR MISSION

SUMMER PROGRAM

Program is for current K-12th graders (2021-2022 school year). Children must be five years old by August 31, 2021 AND have completed traditional Kindergarten.

Morning snack, lunch, and afternoon snack are provided for each child and are included in the price of the program.

All field trips and week-long day trips to Camp Spencer are included in the price of the program.

SUMMER HOURS

Summer Program hours are Monday-Friday, 7:30am - 6:30pm. Doors will not open before 7:30am. Neglecting these operating hours may result in your child being suspended from the program.

The Summer Program begins June 13 and ends August 10. The Club will be closed July 4. (Year-Round Summer Wolf Meadow Students follow a modified schedule.)

DROP-OFF AND PICK-UP

CHILD DROP-OFF is permitted between 7:30am and 9am only. Kids must exit from the right side of the car. Cars are not allowed to park in the drop-off lane.

CHILD PICK-UP Parent / driver must park in a designated parking spot and come inside to Club Central, located through the left door under the covered drop-off area

MEDICATION

The Club does not have medical personnel on staff. Club staff will dispense medication to a child only with the written consent of the parent.

ACTIVITY ROOMS

Activity Rooms are divided into Junior (K-2) and Senior (3-5) wings. Each wing includes: Learning Center, Games Room, Multi-Purpose Room. Children also have access to 3 Gymnasiums and a Technology Center. Teens have designated rooms, outfitted with computers, televisions, video games, books and board games.

THE DAILY ROUTINE

- 7:30am 9am Check-in. Children report to homeroom and notify their group leader whether they brought lunch or if they will order lunch Club lunch. Children stay in homeroom and are served breakfast until 9:15am.
- 9:15am-6pm Children follow an activity schedule
- 11:45pm-1:45pm *Lunch
- 3:45pm-4:30pm Afternoon snack

*Lunches are served during one of four 30 minute time frames

MEALS

During the Summer Program, a morning snack and lunch are provided, free of charge, through the USDA Summer Food Service Program. An afternoon snack is also provided through the Second Harvest Food Bank. Children are permitted to bring lunch or snacks from home. Club does not provide substitute foods to offset allergies.

PERSONAL ITEMS

The Club will not take responsibility for lost or stolen items. Valuables such as cell phones, trading cards, handheld games, etc. are prohibited.

CODE OF CONDUCT

The Club Code of Conduct is included in registration materials and the Program Parent Guides. The Club takes the Code very seriously, and reserves the authority to enforce it in the best interest of the Club.
